Whatcom Lodge Report

Special Communication: Our Thurs. May 4th meeting was attended by 19 Whatcom Brothers and 8 visitors. The purpose of this Special was to confer the MM Degree on Bro. Bruce Smith. We also had three young men, interested in joining Masonry, attend our pre-meeting dinner.

Degree: The degree was conferred by VW Terrell Goertz with WB Thom Baughn as SD and the Working Tools were presented by JW Ken Peck. The *Master's Lecture* was given by VW Glenn Hutchings & WB Jesse Petersen and the *Charge* given by VW John Browne. At the conclusion of the degree Bro. Bruce signed the By-Laws, paid his Dues and was taken West of the Altar where he was congratulated by the brethren.

Stated Communication: The May 18th Sated meeting was attended by 14 Whatcom Brothers and 1 visitor, WB Arnie Hanson WM of Bellingham Bay #44. Also in attendance was VW Don Higgerson WM of Lynden Int. #56 (who is a Whatcom Brother) and VW Terrell Goertz DDGM (also member of Whatcom Lodge). All were given a hearty welcome.

Masonic Education: It was reported by SW Craig Bruner that we now have Comcast Business Internet at the Bellingham Masonic Center, which is co-supported by Whatcom Lodge and the York Rite Brothers.

SW Craig Bruner also presented to the Lodge three old, but in fair shape, degree trestle-boards. These were manufactured in the 1860's and their color is still good. It was moved, 2nd and approved by the brethren to spend up to \$1,000 to have these trestle-boards framed for protection and to be able to hang them from the wall.

Petitions: Two Petitions were given their first Readings: one is for Plural Membership and the other for the Degrees of Masonry. Investigation Committees were appointed for each and are due to report back at the June 15th Stated Communication.

Masonic Youth: WB Thom Baughn gave his usual outstanding report.
